Dear Governor Murphy:

I am a lifelong resident of Hoboken. I live approximately 200 feet north of the proposed ferry repair/refueling station. Exposing me, my family and neighbors to the risks inherent in living in proximity to such a potentially toxic facility would be unconscionable. I don't believe I need list the myriad downsides to you – they've been well documented.

What I find particularly egregious, however, is that NJ Transit's own feasibility study rated Union Dry Dock the fifth best among all the potential siting alternatives. This information combined with the level of public opposition should be compelling enough for your office to find a more appropriate location for the ferry maintenance facility.
